for

1 AN ACT relating to school districts; exempting tuition for
2 education programs provided to nonresident juvenile
3 detention facility placements from local resource offset
4 under the school foundation program; and providing for an
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-310(a)(ix) is amended to read:

11 **21-13-310. Annual computation of district revenues.**

13 (a) To ensure revenues available to each district are
14 uniformly sufficient to enable compliance with the uniform
15 standards for educational programs prescribed under W.S.
16 21-9-101 and 21-9-102 and to secure state board
17 accreditation of educational programs under W.S.

1 21-2-304(a)(ii), the revenues specified under this
2 subsection shall be deemed state revenues and shall be
3 considered in determining the amount to be distributed to
4 each district under W.S. 21-13-311. A district shall make
5 an annual computation of the following revenues:

7 (ix) The amount of tuition paid to the district
8 during the previous school year, including any amount
9 charged under W.S. 21-4-501 and any amount assessed in
10 excess of the costs incurred for adult education programs,
11 summer school programs, programs provided under an
12 agreement for cooperative educational programs under W.S.
13 21-20-101 through 21-20-111 and any amount assessed for
14 programs and services for children with disabilities, but
15 excluding any tuition assessed by a district for the
16 provision of distance education programs to participating
17 nonresident students pursuant to W.S. 21-13-330 or for the
18 provision of educational programs to a nonresident student
19 placed in a juvenile detention facility pursuant to an
20 agreement with the student's resident school district;

22 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2012.
