A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to supplemental appropriations for school  
 2 facility needs; modifying prior appropriations relating to  
 3 school facilities; making additional appropriations relating to  
 4 school facilities; making certain appropriations subject to  
 5 specified terms and conditions; providing for a transfer of  
 6 funds; and providing for an effective date.

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8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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21 1. In addition to expenditures for major building and facility repair and replacement  
 22 pursuant to W.S. 21-15-109, a school district may expend up to ten percent (10%) of  
 23 the amount distributed under this program for the period commencing July 1, 2018 and  
 24 ending June 30, 2020 for safety and security building and facility needs. No  
 25 expenditure shall be made under this footnote without the approval of the department.

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27 2. Of this other funds appropriation, one hundred seventy thousand six hundred  
 28 ninety-three dollars (\$170,693.00)S0 is appropriated from the capitol building  
 29 rehabilitation and restoration account created by W.S. 9-5-109(j) for purposes of  
 30 funding one (1) full-time position and related costs for the period beginning July

1 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2020. The appropriation and position associated with this  
2 footnote shall not be included in the agency's 2021-2022 standard budget request.

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4 **Section 2.** 2018 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 134, Section  
5 313(d) and by creating new subsections (p) through (r) is  
6 amended to read:

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12 (d) An estimated schedule for deploying projects funded  
13 by amounts appropriated under ~~subsection (g) of~~ this section  
14 and projects funded by previous appropriations, as adopted by  
15 the school facilities commission and as contained within the  
16 2019-2020 biennial budget submitted by the commission under W.S.  
17 21-15-119, as modified by the commission's 2019-2020  
18 supplemental budget request, shall be used by the state  
19 construction department to guide expenditure of appropriated  
20 funds. The estimated schedule developed under this subsection  
21 shall be based upon information, processes, events and  
22 expenditures and shall not be binding upon the department or  
23 the commission.

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2       (p) The following amounts are appropriated from the school  
3 capital construction account to the school facilities commission  
4 for the 2019-2020 biennial budget period:

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6       (i) In addition to amounts appropriated for charter  
7 school leases under paragraph (g)(i) of this section, up to  
8 twenty-seven thousand five hundred eighty dollars (\$27,580.00)  
9 for purposes of a charter school lease for an elementary school  
10 in Albany County School District #1 for the 2019-2020 school  
11 year and four hundred twelve thousand one hundred seventy-one  
12 dollars and twenty cents (\$412,171.20) for purposes of a charter  
13 school lease for a secondary school in Laramie County School  
14 District #1 for the 2019-2020 school year. The amounts to be  
15 distributed under this paragraph shall be reduced to the extent  
16 the amounts are duplicative of any costs funded or paid for by  
17 any alternative mechanism, including pursuant to W.S.  
18 21-3-110(a)(x);

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20       (ii) Up to seventeen million nine hundred eighty-one  
21 thousand three hundred seventy-two dollars (\$17,981,372.00) for  
22 the purpose of constructing a satellite high school in  
23 Sweetwater County School District #1;

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(iii) Notwithstanding 2017 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 205, Section 7(a), up to eight million eight hundred twenty-four thousand three hundred sixty dollars (\$8,824,360.00) for the purpose of constructing an alternative high school in Sheridan County School District #2;

(iv) For unanticipated costs associated with projects funded under paragraphs (ii) and (iii) of this subsection, one million seventy-two thousand two hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$1,072,229.00);

(v) For school safety and security projects and in addition to funds reappropriated under subsection (q) of this section, up to four million nine hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$4,950,000.00). Funds appropriated under this paragraph and reappropriated under subsection (q) of this section shall only be expended on projects approved by the school facilities commission. The commission shall only approve security projects pursuant to a commission established process that ensures that funds distributed under this paragraph maximize improvements to student and staff safety. The commission shall consult with school districts to facilitate, to the extent efficient and

1 practicable, consolidated procurement of school safety and  
2 security projects among school districts.

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4 (q) Six million one hundred fifty-two thousand eight  
5 hundred ten dollars and ninety-one cents (\$6,152,810.91) or as  
6 much thereof as is available as contained in 2014 Wyoming  
7 Session Laws, Chapter 82, Section 1(e)(ix), as amended by 2015  
8 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 194, Section 1, is hereby  
9 reappropriated to the school facilities commission for purposes  
10 of funding school safety and security projects pursuant to  
11 paragraph (p)(v) of this section.

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13 (r) Two hundred seventy-five thousand six hundred sixty-  
14 nine dollars (\$275,669.00) or as much thereof as is available  
15 as contained in 2016 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 25, Section  
16 1(q)(ii)(A), as amended by 2017 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter  
17 200, Section 1, for modular projects for Converse County School  
18 District #1 is hereby reappropriated to the school facilities  
19 commission for the purpose of replacing an elementary school  
20 modular building in Converse County School District #1.

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22 **Section 3.** The state auditor shall transfer twenty-six  
23 million eight hundred ninety thousand one hundred ninety-two

1 dollars and twenty cents (\$26,890,192.20) from the general fund  
2 to the school capital construction account.

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4       **Section 4.** This act is effective immediately upon  
5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as  
6 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
