Wyoming lottery distributions.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming lottery; extending dates for
2 distribution of lottery proceeds as specified; and
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-17-111(b) (intro) and (c) is amended
8 to read:

10 **9-17-111. Disposition of lottery proceeds.**

12 (b) On or before the fifteenth day of each quarter,
13 the corporation shall transfer to the treasurer's office,
14 for credit to the lottery account which is hereby created,
15 the amount of all net proceeds minus prizes and amounts

1 earned pursuant to subsection (a) of this section during
2 the preceding quarter. Upon their deposit into the
3 account, any monies representing a deposit of net proceeds
4 shall then become the unencumbered property of the state of
5 Wyoming and the corporation shall have no power to agree or
6 undertake otherwise. Until June 30, ~~2019~~2022, the first
7 six million dollars (\$6,000,000.00) in each fiscal year of
8 these monies shall be paid by the treasurer as they accrue
9 to the treasurers of the counties, cities and towns for
10 payment into their respective general funds. The percentage
11 of the balance that will be distributed to each county and
12 its cities and towns will be determined by computing the
13 percentage that net sales taxes collected attributable to
14 vendors as defined in W.S. 39-15-101(a)(xv) in each county
15 including its cities and towns bear to total net sales
16 taxes collected of vendors as defined in W.S.
17 39-15-101(a)(xv) in all counties including their cities and
18 towns. This percentage of the monies shall be distributed
19 within each county as follows:

21 (c) Until June 30, ~~2019~~2022, after six million
22 dollars (\$6,000,000.00) is distributed in each fiscal year
23 as provided in subsection (b) of this section, any

1 remaining monies deposited to the lottery account which are
2 attributable to that fiscal year shall be paid by the
3 treasurer to common school account within the permanent
4 land fund.

6 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
