- 2 of defrauding another person is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 3 punishable by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars
- 4 (\$1,000), imprisonment for not more than one (1) year, or

- 9 (i) "Electronic means" includes opening an
- 10 e-mail account or an account or profile on a site
- 11 transmitted via the internet;

- 13 (ii) "Internet" means as defined in W.S.
- 14 9-2-1035(a)(iii).

- 16 (c) In addition to any other civil remedy available,
- 17 a person who suffers damage or loss by reason of a
- 18 violation of subsection (a) of this section may bring a
- 19 civil action against the violator for compensatory damages
- 20 and injunctive relief or other equitable relief.
