A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the creation of unified school
2 districts; eliminating the pupil enrollment requirement for
3 nonunified school districts; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-6-208 is amended to read:

9

10 **21-6-208. Creation of new unified school districts**
11 **from within boundaries of existing school districts.**

13 (a) Whenever at least one hundred (100) qualified
14 electors of any area within an existing school district,
15 which area includes both a high school and one (1) or more
16 elementary schools with a total K-12 enrollment of more
17 than five hundred (500) pupils, petition the district

1 boundary board for creation of the area into a new unified
2 school district, the district boundary board may, after
3 holding a hearing on the petition, submit a proposal to
4 form the area into a new unified school district to the
5 state committee.

7 (b) Whenever at least one hundred (100) qualified
8 electors of any nonunified school district, which includes
9 at least one (1) elementary school, petition the district
10 boundary board for authority to designate the area as a
11 unified school district, the district boundary board may,
12 after holding a hearing on the petition, submit a proposal
13 to form the district into a new unified school district to
14 the state committee.

16 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
