for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; decreasing requirements for  
2 minor political party status; extending time for  
3 cancellation of registration; and providing for an  
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-1-102(a)(xviii) and 22-3-115(a)(i)  
9 are amended to read:

11 **22-1-102. Definitions.**

12

13 (a) The definitions contained in this chapter apply  
14 to words and phrases used in this Election Code and govern  
15 the construction of those words and phrases unless they are

1 specifically modified by the context in which they appear.

2 As used in this Election Code:

4 (xviii) "Minor political party" means a  
5 political organization whose candidate for any one (1) of  
6 the offices of the United States house of representatives,  
7 governor or secretary of state, received not less than two  
8 percent (2%) nor more than ten percent (10%) of the total  
9 votes cast for that office in either of the two (2) most  
10 recent general ~~election~~elections;

12 **22-3-115. Grounds for cancellation of registration.**

13

14 (a) A registered elector's registration shall be  
15 cancelled for any one (1) of the following reasons:

16

17 (i) Failure to vote in any two (2) consecutive  
18 general ~~election~~elections;

20 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
