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1 (iii) The following shall apply to the time and 2 place of sale, the purchasers, unsold property and the 3 certificate of purchase:

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5 (B) Any person who offers Sales may be made 6 by lottery or by public auction, without appraisal, to the highest bidder for cash whose bid is at least sufficient to 7 pay the amount of taxes, interest, penalties and costs 8 9 including charges provided by paragraph (ix) of this 10 subsection due on any real property. is considered the 11 purchaser thereof. The purchaser shall immediately pay the 12 county treasurer all amounts due on the real property in 13 the absence of which the real property shall again be offered for sale and the original purchaser disqualified. 14 Any real property which cannot be sold for the amount of 15 16 taxes, interest, penalties and costs shall be bid in for 17 the county by the county treasurer. Real property bid in 18 for the county shall be assessed each year and taxes placed 19 thereon the same as other real property but shall be placed 20 on a separate assessment roll and the valuation shall not 21 be included in the county valuation. A list of the 22 property shall be sent to the board on the first Monday in 23 July for statistical purposes;
