8 and 22-5-214 are amended to read:

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10 **22-1-102.** Definitions.

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12 (a) The definitions contained in this chapter apply

13 to words and phrases used in this Election Code and govern

14 the construction of those words and phrases unless they are

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specifically modified by the context in which they appear.

As used in this Election Code:

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4 (xxiii) "Poll list" is the list of registered

5 voters as compiled by the clerk for use by election judges

6 at the polls. The poll list shall:

8 (F) Provide for the notation of:

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10 (IV) For general elections only,

11 **e**lectors who change political party affiliation at the

12 polls.

14 22-5-212. When declaration of party affiliation

15 required.

17 An elector requesting a major party ballot must declare his

18 party affiliation, or sign an application for change of

19 affiliation in accordance with W.S. 22-5-214 before he may

20 receive a party ballot. An elector may vote only the

21 nonpartisan ballot and if so, is not required to declare

22 his party affiliation. Requesting a partisan primary

23 election ballot constitutes a declaration of party

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affiliation. A change in declaration of party affiliation 1 2 shall be in accordance with W.S. 22-5-214 and entered on 3 the poll list by the election judge. 4 22-5-214. Change in party affiliation. 5 6 An elector may change his party affiliation by completing 7 8 an application signed before a notarial officer or election 9 official, and filing it with the county clerk not less than 10 fourteen (14) thirty (30) days before the primary or 11 general election or at the polls on the day of the primary 12 or general election., or when requesting an absentee 13 ballot. 14 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2017. 15 16 17 (END)

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
