14 SUPERVISED MEDICAL USE OF CANNABIDIOL

16 **35-7-2101.** Definitions.

1 2 (a) As used in this article: 3 4 (i) "Cannabidiol" or "CBD" means an oil or other preparation intended as a medicine made from the cannabis 5 plant which contains primarily cannabidiol as its active 6 ingredient and which contains no tetrahydrocannabinol or 7 8 THC or any other psychoactive substance; 9 (ii) "Department" means the department 10 of 11 health; 12 (iii) "Parent" means a parent or legal guardian 13 of a minor who is responsible for the minor's medical care; 14 15 16 (iv) "Prescribing physician" means a person who is licensed to practice medicine pursuant to the Medical 17 18 Practice Act and who is certified by a nationally 19 recognized professional organization as a neurosurgeon, 20 neurologist, pain management specialist, psychiatrist, 21 oncologist or ophthalmologist;

1	(v) "Registrant" means the person who holds a
2	registration card issued by the department pursuant to this
3	article;

5	(vi) "Registration card" means a card issued by
6	the department under W.S. 35-7-2102.

8	35-7-2102. CBD registration cards.

10	(a) The department shall issue a CBD registration
11	card to a person who:
12	
13	(i) Is at least eighteen (18) years of age;
14	
15	(ii) Is a resident of Wyoming;
16	
17	(iii) Provides a statement to the department
18	which is signed by a prescribing physician and specifies
19	that the person may benefit from treatment with CBD;
20	
21	(iv) Pays a fee to the department as specified
22	in this section; and

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1	(v) Submits an application to the department on
2	a form created by the department that contains:
3	
4	(A) The person's name and address;
5	
6	(B) A copy of the person's valid photo
7	identification; and
8	
9	(C) Any other information the department
10	determines necessary to implement this article.
11	
12	(b) The department shall issue a registration card to
13	a parent who:
14	
15	(i) Is at least eighteen (18) years of age;
16	
17	(ii) Is applying for a registration card on
18	behalf of a minor who is in the parent's care and is a
19	resident of Wyoming;

21	(iii) Provides the department with a statement
22	signed by a prescribing physician that the minor may
23	benefit from treatment with CBD;

2	(iv) Pays the department a fee as provided in
3	subsection (e) of this section; and

5	(v) Submits an application to the department on
6	a form created by the department, which contains:

8	(A) The parent's name and address;

10	(B) The minor's name;

12	(C) A copy of the parent's valid photo
13	identification; and

1 (ii) The names of each minor receiving care from 2 a parent who is issued a registration card under this 3 section. 4 5 The department shall promulgate rules (d) and regulations to establish: 6 7 8 (i) The information an applicant is required to 9 provide to the department under this article; 10 11 (ii) The form of the registration card issued 12 under this article; and 13 14 (iii) Any other requirements reasonably 15 necessary to implement this article. 16 17 (e) The department shall establish a fee for maintaining and administering the registry required by this 18 section in an amount to ensure that, to the extent 19 20 practicable, the total revenue generated from the fees 21 collected approximates, but does not exceed, the direct and indirect costs of maintaining and administering the 22

registry. Fees collected under this section shall be 1

2 deposited in the general fund.

4 (f) A registration card issued under this section is

valid for one (1) year and is renewable if, at the time of 5

renewal, the registrant meets the requirements of this 6

section. 7

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9 The prescribing physician who signs a statement

required by this section shall: 10

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12 (i) Keep a record of his evaluation

observation of each patient who is an applicant, registrant 13

or minor under a registrant's care including the patient's 14

15 response to CBD; and

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17 (ii) Transmit a copy of the record to the

18 department in accordance with rules and regulations adopted

19 by the department.

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The department shall maintain a database of 21 (h)

records received under this section. The department shall 22

treat the records as confidential and not subject to the 23

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- 1 public records act, W.S. 16-4-201 through 16-4-205,
- 2 provided that the department may share the records with a
- 3 higher education institution for the purpose of studying
- 4 CBD if the records are redacted so that the patient cannot
- 5 be identified individually.

- 7 35-7-2103. Exemption from criminal and civil
- 8 penalties for the medical use of CBD.

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- 10 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 11 chapter, no person who possesses or uses CBD shall be
- 12 subject to any penalties provided in this chapter for
- 13 possession or use of the CBD if the individual:

14

- 15 (i) Possesses or uses the CBD pursuant to the
- 16 direction of a prescribing physician;

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- 18 (ii) Possesses a registration card issued by the
- 19 department under W.S. 35-7-2102; and

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- 21 (iii) Can provide, through a certificate of
- 22 analysis or otherwise, evidence that the medication does

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23 not contain tetrahydrocannabinol.

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2	(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
3	chapter, no person who possesses CBD and administers the
4	CBD to a minor shall be subject to any penalties provided
5	in this chapter if:

7	(i) The individual is the minor's parent or
8	legal guardian; and

10	(ii) The individual possesses a registration
11	card issued by the department under W.S. 35-7-2102(b).

when used in accordance with the provisions of W.S.
