11	authorization document, foreign passport (with United
12	States visa affixed and accompanied by an approved document
13	documenting the applicant's most recent admittance to the
14	United States), state issued driver's license or
15	identification card which complies with federal law and
16	applicable regulations, or other document required by the
17	division to establish identity where reasons beyond the
18	applicant's control prevent the applicant from presenting
