

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0129

Glider kit vehicles-title and registration.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing requirements  
2 for glider kit vehicle certificates of title; providing a  
3 definition; making conforming amendments; and providing for  
4 an effective date.

5

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-112 is created to read:

9

10 **31-2-112. Glider kit vehicle certificate of title.**

11

12 (a) Any county clerk may issue a glider kit vehicle  
13 certificate of title for a glider kit vehicle, as defined  
14 in W.S. 31-1-101(a)(xv)(R), containing the following

1 notation "glider kit" conspicuously displayed on the face  
2 of the certificate.

3

4 (b) Applications for a glider kit vehicle certificate  
5 of title shall be under oath and contain or be accompanied  
6 by:

7

8 (i) The name and address of the owner and the  
9 person to whom the certificate of title is to be delivered;  
10

11 (ii) A description of the vehicle including the  
12 make and model year of the body that the glider kit vehicle  
13 resembles, the vehicle identification number, type of body  
14 and motive power;

15

16 (iii) A statement from the dealer or final  
17 assembler indicating:

18

19 (A) For glider kit vehicles completely  
20 assembled by the manufacturer:

21

22 (I) The manufacturer's suggested  
23 retail price (MSRP) for the completed glider kit vehicle,

1 including the glider kit, engine, transmission, rear axles,  
2 wheels, tires and any other body, cab or mechanical  
3 component;

4

5 (II) Certification that the glider kit  
6 vehicle was newly assembled when sold to the applicant.

7

8 (B) For glider kit vehicles fully assembled  
9 after purchase from the manufacturer, a notarized statement  
10 of value or appraisal from the final assembler of the  
11 glider kit vehicle. The statement of value or appraisal  
12 shall include:

13

14 (I) The value of the completed glider  
15 kit vehicle, including the glider kit, engine,  
16 transmission, rear axles, wheels, tires and any other body,  
17 cab or mechanical component;

18

19 (II) A statement of work performed to  
20 completely assemble the glider kit vehicle.

21

22 (iv) Certification of the applicant's ownership  
23 and any liens or encumbrances upon the glider kit vehicle;

1

2           (v) Such other information as required by the  
3 department or county clerk, including a vehicle bill of  
4 sale, any other information required under W.S. 31-2-103  
5 and any documentation necessary to verify proof of  
6 ownership including an affidavit for proof of ownership or  
7 any surety bond required by this act. An affidavit for  
8 proof of ownership shall be by form prescribed pursuant to  
9 W.S. 31-1-201(d) and shall be utilized by each county of  
10 this state.

11

12           (c) The owner of a glider kit vehicle who has been  
13 issued a certificate of title under another section of this  
14 article may apply for a glider kit vehicle certificate of  
15 title under this section.

16

17           (d) A certificate of title issued under this section  
18 shall list as the model year, the model year that the body  
19 of the glider kit vehicle resembles, unless the engine,  
20 transmission, drive axle or rear axle of the glider kit  
21 vehicle are not new and at least two (2) of these  
22 components were taken from the same vehicle, in which case  
23 the model year listed on the title shall be the model year

1 of the oldest of the components listed in this subsection.  
2 For purposes of this subsection, components that have been  
3 refurbished and provided by the manufacturer shall be  
4 deemed new.

5  
6 (e) For glider kit vehicle certificates of title  
7 issued under this section, the vehicle identification  
8 number that is listed on the certificate of title shall be  
9 the vehicle identification number listed on the  
10 manufacturer's statement of origin. If the manufacturer's  
11 statement of origin does not list a vehicle identification  
12 number, a vehicle identification number shall be assigned  
13 pursuant to W.S. 31-11-105.

14  
15 (f) Glider kit vehicles shall be titled, registered  
16 and licensed pursuant to the provisions of this chapter and  
17 chapter 18 of this title.

18  
19 **Section 2.** W.S. 31-1-101(a)(xv) by creating a new  
20 subparagraph (R) and 31-18-201(b)(intro) are amended to  
21 read:

22  
23 **31-1-101. Definitions.**

1

2 (a) Except as otherwise provided, as used in this  
3 act:

4

5 (xv) "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle which  
6 is self-propelled except vehicles moved solely by human  
7 power or motorized skateboards. The term includes the  
8 following vehicles as hereafter defined:

9

10 (R) "Glider kit vehicle" means every large  
11 truck manufactured from a kit manufactured by a  
12 manufacturer of large trucks that consists of a frame, a  
13 cab complete with wiring and instruments, fenders, hood,  
14 front axles and wheels. The "glider kit vehicle" includes  
15 only those vehicles made into a complete assembly by the  
16 addition of the engine, transmission, rear axles, wheels  
17 and tires.

18

19 **31-18-201. Commercial vehicles; registration;**  
20 **exemptions.**

21

22 (b) Except as otherwise provided by W.S. 31-18-202  
23 and subsections (h) and (j) of this section, every owner of

1 a commercial vehicle or fleet of commercial vehicles shall  
2 comply with the requirements for certificates of title  
3 contained in W.S. 31-2-101 through 31-2-105 and, for glider  
4 kit vehicles, the additional requirements contained in W.S.  
5 31-2-112, and register and license the vehicle or fleet for  
6 operation in Wyoming in accordance with the time  
7 requirements contained in W.S. 31-2-201(a)(i) and (ii) as  
8 follows:

9

10 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2018.
