14	(i) Two and eight-tenths percent (2.8%) of his
15	the member's final average compensation multiplied by the
16	number of member's years in his first twenty-five (25)
17	years of his period of credited service, not to exceed an
18	annual benefit amount equal to the average compensation
19	paid to the member during the calendar year when the member
20	marks his twenty-fifth year of credited service.
