1 2 (a) For purposes of this section: 3 4 (i) "Autologous blood donation" means when a person donates the person's own blood for personal use 5 during a future medical procedure; б 7 (ii) "Direct blood donation" means when a person 8 9 donates the person's blood specifically for the use of 10 another person during the other person's future medical 11 procedure. 12 (b) A hospital or other health care facility licensed 13 under this title shall allow a person on whom a medical 14 15 procedure is to be performed at the facility to donate a 16 health care provider-ordered autologous or direct blood 17 donation before the medical procedure if the facility performs blood donations. 18

20 (c) A blood bank that facilitates autologous or 21 direct blood donations shall comply with a health care 22 provider's order prescribing an autologous or direct blood 23 donation for a person, unless the person donating blood is

in ill health, has a heart condition that makes donating
blood inadvisable, the person weighs too little to donate
blood, or the person cannot or should not donate blood for
any other reason.

6 (d) A blood bank may charge not more than their 7 regular fee to facilitate an autologous or direct blood 8 donation ordered by a health care provider under subsection 9 (c) of this section. The blood bank may charge a fee to 10 store the donated blood until it is used by the person 11 meant to receive it.

13 Section 2. The department of health shall promulgate 14 all rules necessary to implement this act.
