Daylight saving time-exemption.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to daylight saving time; exempting the
2 state from the daylight saving time change; providing for
3 the observance of standard time; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 8-4-110 is created to read:

9

10 **8-4-110. Exemption from daylight saving time change.**

12 Pursuant to the authority granted by 15 U.S.C. § 260a(a),
13 the state is exempt from the provisions of 15 U.S.C. §
14 260a(a) that require the standard time to be advanced by
15 one (1) hour during a stated period of each year. The

1 state, including all its political subdivisions, shall be
2 subject to this section and shall not advance the standard
3 time pursuant to 15 U.S.C. § 260a(a).

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2018.
