2 (a) A city or town that operates a trash or recycling
3 collection service, municipal waterworks or sanitary sewer
4 system shall not collect or attempt to collect past due
5 payments from a property owner for any of those services
6 through any means when the property owner has not

(b) When a tenant resides on a property and the

between a property owner and a city or town executed before
