23-1-703. Limitation of number of big or trophy game

1 The commission shall reserve eighty percent (80%) (e) 2 of the moose, and seventy-five percent (75%) of the ram and 3 ewe and lamb bighorn sheep, and ninety percent (90%) of the 4 mountain goat and grizzly bear licenses to be issued in any 5 one (1) year for resident hunters. 6 7 23-2-101. Fees; restrictions; nonresident application 8 fee; nonresident licenses; verification of residency required. 9 10 11 Except as provided in W.S. 23-2-107, resident and 12 nonresident license applicants shall pay an application fee 13 in an amount specified by this subsection upon submission 14 of an application for purchase of any limited quota drawing 15 for big or trophy game license or wild bison license. 16 resident application fee for mountain goat licenses shall not exceed ten dollars (\$10.00), the resident application 17 18 fee for all other big or trophy game licenses shall be five 19 dollars (\$5.00) and the nonresident application fee for big or trophy game licenses or wild bison licenses shall be 20 21 fourteen dollars (\$14.00). The application fee is in

addition to the fees prescribed by subsections (f) and (j)

of this section and by W.S. 23-2-107 and shall be payable

1 to the department either directly or through an authorized

2 selling agent of the department. At the beginning of each

3 month, the commission shall set aside all of the fees

4 collected during calendar year 1980 and not to exceed

5 twenty-five percent (25%) of the fees collected thereafter

6 pursuant to this subsection to establish and maintain a

7 working balance of five hundred thousand dollars

8 (\$500,000.00), to compensate owners or lessees of property

9 damaged by game animals and game birds.

13 (e) A resident applicant shall pay a license fee of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) for a license to harvest any 14 wild bison or two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for a 15 16 license to harvest a female or calf wild bison and shall pay the fee required by W.S. 23-2-101(e) an application fee 17 not to exceed twenty dollars (\$20.00). A nonresident 18 applicant shall pay a license fee of two thousand five 19 20 hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) for a license to harvest any 21 wild bison or one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for a license to harvest a female or calf wild bison and shall 22 23 pay the fee required by W.S. 23-2-101(e). The fee charged

1 under W.S. 23-1-701 shall be in addition to the fee imposed under this subsection. 2 3 (g) The commission shall reserve ninety percent (90%) 4 5 of the wild bison licenses by type to be issued in any one 6 (1) year for resident hunters. 7 8 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2016. 9 10
