1 the following information on a monthly basis beginning August 1, 2025: 2 3 4 (i) Incidents of workplace violence against health care providers; 5 6 7 (ii) The category of the person committing the violence, including: 8 9 10 (A) Patient; 11 12 (B) Health care provider; 13 14 (C) Family members or acquaintances of patients; 15 16 17 (D) Others, as specified by the person 18 making the report. 19 20 (iii) Patient-related risk factors that may have contributed to the violence, such as mental health disorder 21

diagnoses or substance use;

1 (iv) Environmental risk factors, such as 2 restricted patient visitation, lack of security or 3 excessive wait times; 4 (v) The types of incidents, including physical 5 assaults, attempted physical assaults, verbal abuse, 6 threats of harm or verbal discrimination based on race, sex 7 8 or gender; 9 10 (vi) The victims of the reported incidents by 11 job type; 12 (vii) The location of each incident, by physical 13 address and department of the hospital, clinic or long-term 14 15 care facility. 16 17 (b) The department of workforce services shall report 18 the information in subsection (a) of this section, as well 19 as the total number of incidents reported between July 1, 2025 and July 1, 2026, to the joint labor, health and 20 21 social services interim committee not later than October 1,
