Property damage threshold for police reports.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the regulation of traffic on highways;  
2 raising the vehicle damage threshold requiring a written  
3 police report; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-1106(c) is amended to read:

9 **31-5-1106. Written reports required of police**  
10 **officers; reporting of vehicles struck by bullets.**

12 (c) Every police officer who investigates a motor  
13 vehicle accident resulting in bodily injury to or death of  
14 any person or total property damage to an apparent extent  
15 of ~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00)~~ three thousand dollars

1 (\$3,000.00) or more, either at the time of and at the scene  
2 of the accident or thereafter by interviewing the  
3 participants or witnesses shall forward a written report of  
4 the accident to the highway department within ten (10) days  
5 after his investigation of the accident.

7 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2016.
