8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-302 is amended to read:

- 10 31-5-302. Establishment of specific maximum speed
- 11 limits by superintendent.

- 13 (a) Whenever the superintendent determines upon the
- 14 basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, or in
- 15 the event of a vehicle or weather emergency, that a maximum
- 16 speed greater or less than that authorized herein is safe

and reasonable under the conditions found to exist at any 1 2 intersection or other place or upon any part of the state 3 highway system, the superintendent, except as provided for 4 in W.S. 31-5-303(b), may determine and declare a reasonable and safe maximum limit thereat, which shall be effective 5 when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected 6 and which shall not exceed eighty (80) miles per hour on 7 interstate highways. Except as otherwise provided in 8 9 subsection (b) of this section, the maximum speed limit may be declared to be effective at all times or at such times 10 11 as are indicated upon the signs and differing limits may be 12 established for different times of day, different types of 13 vehicles, varying weather conditions, and other factors 14 bearing on safe speeds, which shall be effective when posted upon appropriate fixed or variable signs. 15 16 section does not grant power to the superintendent to declare statewide or countywide maximum speed limits but 17 grants power to declare maximum speed limits for the public 18 19 safety in localized geographic areas.

21 <u>(b) Whenever the superintendent designates a maximum</u>
22 <u>speed limit of eighty (80) miles per hour on an interstate</u>
23 highway, the maximum speed limit shall be indicated upon

1 variable electronic signs and different limits shall be 2 established as determined necessary by the superintendent 3 for different times of day, different types of vehicles, 4 varying weather conditions and other factors bearing on 5 safe speeds, which shall be effective when posted upon electronic variable signs. 6 7 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2015. 8 9
