Supplemental budget requests-limitations.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state budgets; limiting supplemental  
2 budget requests as specified; and providing for an  
3 effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1013(d) by creating a new  
8 paragraph (v) and by renumbering (v) as (vi) is amended to  
9 read:

10

11 **9-2-1013. State budget; distribution of copies to**  
12 **legislators; copies and reports of authorizations.**

13

14 (d) In addition to the items contained in subsection  
15 (a) of this section and notwithstanding any other  
16 recommendations made by the governor, the state budget

1 shall also include the governor's recommendations for  
2 appropriations for the ensuing two (2) years, or if a  
3 supplemental budget request, the remainder of the budget  
4 period, subject to the following:

5

6 (v) Any recommendations in a supplemental budget  
7 request from the governor or state agencies shall be  
8 limited to amendments to the budget as follows:

9

10 (A) Necessary reductions occasioned by  
11 state revenue forecast shortfalls;

12

13 (B) Allocations necessitated by human or  
14 natural disasters;

15

16 (C) Allocations necessitated by emergencies  
17 as certified by the governor;

18

19 (D) For the governor's recommendations,  
20 increased allocations for unexpected forecast balances;

21

22 (E) Recommendations regarding increases or  
23 decreases to savings; and

24

1                            (F) Necessary personnel adjustments.

2

3                    ~~(v)~~(vi) Nothing in this subsection prevents the  
4 governor from recommending an additional, alternative  
5 budget without the limitations specified in this  
6 subsection.

7

8            **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
9 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
10 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
11 Constitution.
