1 (k) No person or entity shall sell electricity for 2 use by a customer in another public utility's certificated service territory, including by providing service to a 3 4 point of delivery outside of the other public utility's certificated territory for consumption within the other 5 public utility's certificated territory, without a customer 6 7 allocation agreement between the customer, the seller of 8 the electricity and the other public utility. Any violation of this subsection shall entitle the aggrieved public 9 10 utility to recover in a civil action damages for lost 11 income from the unlawful invasion of its certificated 12 service territory, plus all reasonable attorney fees and expenses incurred by the aggrieved public utility in the 13 civil action brought under this subsection. 14
