A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming national guard; providing

2 legislative findings; prohibiting the release of the

3 Wyoming national guard into active duty combat as

4 specified; and providing for an effective date.

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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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8 **Section 1.** The Wyoming legislature finds that this

9 act, creating the Defend the Guard Act, follows the

10 principles embodied in the United States constitution and

11 the writings of the founders. Article I, section 8 of the

12 United States constitution vests in the congress the

13 exclusive power to declare war. By abdicating the war

14 powers to the executive branch, the United States congress

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1	has failed to follow the United States constitution and the
2	intent of the founders.
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4	Section 2. W.S. 19-9-104 is created to read:
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6	19-9-104. Defend the guard act.
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8	(a) This section shall be known and may be cited as
9	the "Defend the Guard Act".
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11	(b) For the purposes of this section:
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13	(i) "Active duty combat" means performing the
14	following services in the active federal military service
15	of the United States:
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17	(A) Participation in an armed conflict;
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19	(B) Performance of a hazardous service
20	relating to an armed conflict in a foreign state; or
21	
22	(C) Performance of a duty through an
23	instrumentality of war.

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2 (ii) "Official declaration of war" means an 3 official declaration of war made by the United States 4 congress pursuant to article I, section 8, clause 11 of the

United States constitution.

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7 (c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the 8 Wyoming national guard and any member thereof shall not be released from the state into active duty combat unless the 9 10 United States congress has passed an official declaration 11 of war or has taken an official action pursuant to article 12 I, section 8, clause 15 of the United States constitution to explicitly call forth the Wyoming national guard and any 13 member thereof for the enumerated purposes of expressly 14 executing the laws of the union, repelling invasion or 15 16 suppressing an insurrection. The governor shall take all 17 actions necessary to comply with the requirements of this 18 section.

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20 (d) Nothing in this section limits or prohibits the 21 governor from consenting to the deployment of any Wyoming 22 national guard member under title 32 of the United States 23 Code for the purpose of providing defense support for civil

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1 authority missions within the United States and United

2 States territories.

4 **Section 3.** W.S. 19-9-204(b) is amended to read:

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6 19-9-204. Command of military force called into

7 service.

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9 (b) Subject to W.S. 19-9-104 the national guard of

10 the state may be ordered into the service of the United

11 States by the president of the United States for any

12 purpose for which he is authorized to use militia of the

13 states by the constitution of the United States.

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15 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
