A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to vehicle insurance; prohibiting motor
2 vehicle insurance contract provisions that prevent additive
3 coverage; specifying applicability; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 26-15-137 is created to read:

9

10 **26-15-137. Stacking of uninsured and underinsured**
11 **benefits.**

13 (a) The limits of coverages available for a person
14 covered under a motor vehicle insurance policy that
15 provides uninsured or underinsured motorist coverage shall

1 be the sum of the policy limits for each motor vehicle for
2 which an injured person is covered under the policy and
3 shall be in addition to the extent of any applicable other
4 motorist's coverage.

5

6 (b) No insurer delivering or issuing for delivery in
7 this state any new or renewal policy or contract of motor
8 vehicle insurance, or both, shall include any policy or
9 contract provision that prohibits the stacking of coverages
10 as authorized in subsection (a) of this section.

11

12 **Section 2.** This act applies to motor vehicle
13 insurance policies and contracts delivered, issued for
14 delivery or renewed on and after July 1, 2021.

15

16 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2021.
