## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to special education; providing for the 2 creation of accounts to provide for the costs of special 3 education programs and services delivered outside of a

4 public K-12 school; providing for a continuous

5 appropriation; providing for a criminal offense and

6 penalties; and providing for an effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10 **Section 1**. W.S. 21-4-701 is created to read:

1 21-4-701. Education savings accounts for special

2 education programs and services; appropriation; penalties.

4 (a) The state superintendent shall create a system to

5 provide education savings accounts for students receiving

6 special education programs and services in accordance with

7 this section.

8

9 (b) The state superintendent shall create an

10 education savings account for a student, upon request of a

11 parent or guardian, for any student age five (5) years to

12 twenty-one (21) years who:

13

14 (i) Is a student with disabilities as identified

15 under the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education

16 Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq; or

17

18 (ii) Has been diagnosed within the preceding

19 three (3) years as having an acute or chronic condition

20 that significantly impedes the student's ability to succeed

21 in school, including deafness, blindness, orthopedic

22 disability or neurodevelopmental disability.

23

1 Before July 1 of each year, (C) the state 2 superintendent shall annually calculate an appropriate amount with which to fund each account. The amount for each 3 4 account shall be sufficient to pay for the expected costs 5 incurred by the parents or guardians for special education programs and services of the eligible student. The state 6 superintendent by August 1 of each year shall deposit an 7 8 appropriate amount into each education savings account. 9 Funds within the school foundation program account derived 10 federal mineral royalties continuously are appropriated to the state superintendent for purposes of 11 12 funding the education savings accounts created under this 13 section.

(d) Funds within the education savings accounts shall 15 16 be available to the parents or guardians of the eligible 17 students to pay for special education programs and services provided to the students outside of a public K-12 school. 18 19 superintendent shall make funds within the The state 20 accounts available to parents and guardians by use of a 21 debit card and other appropriate means. Unexpended funds within each account shall rollover annually, until the 22 23 student is no longer an eligible student as provided by

- 1 this section, at which time the funds shall revert to the
- 2 school foundation program account.

- 4 (e) The state superintendent may request that parents
- 5 and guardians provide documentation to show that funds
- 6 expended from accounts have been made in accordance with
- 7 law.

8

- 9 (f) Knowingly using account funds for any purpose
- 10 other than to pay for special education programs and
- 11 services shall be a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment
- 12 for not more than six (6) months, a fine of not more than
- one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both.

15 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2021.
