SIXTY-FIFTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING 2019 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to real estate brokers; decreasing the length of time licensed real estate brokers must keep and maintain records of real estate transactions; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 33-28-123 is amended to read:

33-28-123. Retention of records.

Every responsible broker licensed by the commission in this state shall keep and maintain a full set of records of every real estate transaction in which he participates on behalf of or to assist any party to the transaction. The records shall be maintained not less than $\frac{\text{seven }(7) - \text{two }(2)}{\text{two }(2)}$ years from the latest date on which the real estate company participated in the transaction.

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Section 2.	This act is effective July 1, 2019.
