5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-6-130 by creating a new subsection
- 8 (c) is amended to read:

10 22-6-130. Post-election ballot audit.

- 12 (c) In addition to the audit under subsections (a)
- 13 and (b) of this section, following each primary and general
- 14 election, each county clerk shall conduct an audit of the
- 15 ballots in one (1) precinct as provided in this section.

1 The secretary of state shall randomly select one (1) 2 precinct in each county to be audited as provided in this 3 subsection. The county clerk shall conduct a hand count 4 audit of all ballots cast in the precinct selected by the 5 secretary of state and shall compare the hand count result to the result tabulated by the electronic voting system. 6 The audit under this subsection shall be completed not 7 8 later than one (1) week after the date of the election. The results of the audit and the comparison shall immediately 9 10 be reported to the secretary of state. The secretary of 11 state shall adopt rules necessary to implement this 12 subsection, including rules establishing the scope of the audit and the procedures for conducting the audit under 13 this subsection. 14

Section 2. The secretary of state shall adopt rules regarding the hand count audit required under W.S. 22-6-130(c), as created by section 1 of this act, not later than September 1, 2025.
