5 (iv) Criteria and procedures under which 6 students who receive a high school equivalency certificate 7 can qualify for scholarships under this article. A student 8 receiving a high school equivalency certificate shall:

10 (A) Receive the certificate and make application for the initial scholarship no later than two 11 12 (2) years after and no sooner than the graduation date of 13 the student's high school class, unless ordered by a court to complete the requirements for the certificate prior to 14 15 that graduation date or for other good cause shown as 16 determined by the department. Other good cause can be 17 established under this subparagraph, but is not limited to, 18 a showing by the student that the student has been 19 emancipated under W.S. 14-1-201 through 14-1-206 or that 20 the student is a parent or a legal guardian of a minor. The 21 student shall have attended an eligible high school prior to receiving his certificate and shall have received his 22 23 certificate while residing in Wyoming;
