A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to net metering; amending the definition of
2 net metering; providing that an electric utility may
3 authorize a customer-generator to use a net metering system
4 with a generating capacity of greater than twenty-five
5 kilowatts; and providing for an effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-16-101(a)(viii)(B) and 37-16-102 by
10 creating a new subsection (b) are amended to read:

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12 **37-16-101. Definitions.**

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14 (a) As used in this chapter unless the context or a
15 specific article otherwise requires:

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(viii) "Net metering system" means a facility for the production of electrical energy that:

(B) Has a generating capacity of not more than twenty-five (25) kilowatts, except as otherwise provided by W.S. 37-16-102(b);

37-16-102. Electric utility requirements; electric utility authorizations.

(b) An electric utility may authorize a customer-generator to use a net metering system that has a generating capacity of more than twenty-five (25) kilowatts. If an electric utility authorizes the use of a net metering system under this subsection then all terms and conditions regarding use and operation of the net metering system shall be provided for in a contract between the customer-generator and the electric utility.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2019.
