- 16 No person or organization shall receive more than a total

of twelve (12) malt beverage and twenty-four (24) catering 1 permits for sales at the same premises in any one (1) year, 2 3 except: that 4 5 (i) This limitation shall not be applicable to malt beverage permits issued for sales at any fair, rodeo, 6 pari-mutuel event or other similar public event conducted 7 by a public entity upon public premises; - or 8 9 10 (ii) This limitation shall not be applicable for 11 catering permits issued for sales at any enclosed nonprofit or publicly owned civic or events center facility with over 12 13 four hundred (400) seats or over twenty thousand (20,000) 14 square feet. 15 The malt beverage permit and the catering permit 16 (d) 17 shall may be issued on application to the appropriate

An application for a malt beverage permit or catering permit under this section shall be accompanied by a designation of the event for which the application is sought specifying the type of event and the name of the sponsor. applicant applying for a permit authorized by this section and having licensed premises located within a jurisdiction
