## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the Hathaway scholarship program; allowing
- 2 students to petition to increase a scholarship award as
- 3 specified; providing applicability; requiring rulemaking; and
- 4 providing for effective dates.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1304 by creating a new subsection
- 9 (j), 21-16-1305 by creating a new subsection (f) and
- 10 21-16-1308(a)(iv) and by creating a new paragraph (vi) are

13 21-16-1304. Hathaway opportunity, performance and

1 (j) A student receiving a Hathaway performance 2 scholarship who maintains a cumulative grade point average of 3 at least 3.75 for any two (2) consecutive semesters at an 4 eligible institution may apply to the department for receipt 5 of the Hathaway honor scholarship for the remainder of 6 scholarship eligibility provided under W.S. 21-16-1303(d). A student receiving a Hathaway opportunity scholarship who 7 8 maintains a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.75 for any two (2) consecutive semesters at an eligible 9 10 institution may apply to the department for receipt of the Hathaway performance scholarship for the remainder of 11 12 scholarship eliqibility provided under W.S. 21-16-1303(d). A 13 student who successfully petitions for a scholarship of 14 greater value may not petition for successive scholarships of greater value. Eligibility shall be evaluated at the end of 15 16 the spring academic term. The department may delegate to any 17 eligible institution the department's authority to grant a request in accordance with this subsection, but the delegate 18 19 shall only grant a petition in accordance with department 20 rules and regulations establishing procedures and criteria 21 for granting a request for an increase of the Hathaway 22 scholarship under this subsection.

Hathaway provisional opportunity 2 scholarships. 3 4 (f) A student receiving a Hathaway provisional 5 opportunity scholarship who maintains a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.75 for any two (2) consecutive 6 semesters at an eligible institution may apply to the 7 8 department for receipt of the Hathaway performance scholarship for the remainder of scholarship eligibility 9 10 provided under W.S. 21-16-1303(d). A student who successfully petitions for a scholarship of greater value may not petition 11 12 for successive scholarships of greater value. Eliqibility 13 under this subsection shall be evaluated at the end of the spring academic term. The department may delegate to any 14 15 eligible institution the department's authority to grant a 16 request in accordance with this subsection, but the delegate shall only grant a petition in accordance with department 17 rules and regulations establishing procedures and criteria 18 19 for granting a request for an increase of the Hathaway 20 scholarship under this subsection. 21

4 (iv) Each eligible institution receiving application from applying for a 5 а student scholarship shall preliminarily determine the 6 student's eligibility for the scholarship. For students initially 7 8 applying for a scholarship, unless the student's complete academic record is available, the GPA used to preliminarily 9 10 determine eligibility shall be based upon the student's 11 official high school transcript after either the end of the 12 first semester of a student's senior year or the second 13 semester of a student's junior year, at the sole discretion of the eligible institution. For students graduating prior 14 15 to their senior year the GPA used to preliminarily determine 16 eligibility shall be based upon the student's official high school transcript as of the end of the semester immediately 17 prior to the last semester before the student's graduation. 18 19 High school GPAs for final eligibility determinations for 20 students initially applying for a scholarship under this 21 article shall be based upon the student's complete high school Upon final determination of scholarship 22 academic record. eligibility, <u>including any increase in scholarship level</u> 23

1 granted under W.S. 21-16-1304(j) or 21-16-1305(f), each 2 community college shall certify to the community college 3 commission not later than thirty (30) days after the semester 4 commences, a list of students enrolled at the institution who 5 qualify for a scholarship under this article, including the amount of each scholarship. The university shall certify to 6 the department within forty-five (45) days after the semester 7 8 commences a like list for students enrolled at the university. 9 The director of the community college commission shall verify 10 within ten (10) days after receiving all lists from community 11 colleges whether there is any duplication of students on the 12 community college lists, shall provide the lists to the 13 department and shall certify to the department the amount each college is to receive under this article. Students 14 15 attending more than one (1) eligible institution shall enter 16 into a consortium agreement with the multiple institutions 17 whereby the student shall designate a home institution to be paid the entire Hathaway scholarship amount for which the 18 19 student qualifies;

**Section 2.** This act shall apply prospectively. 6 academic records of Hathaway scholarship recipients prior to 7 8 the effective date of this act shall not be considered in 9 determining eligibility to receive an increase of the 10 Hathaway scholarship based on academic performance in 11 accordance with W.S. 21-16-1304(j) or 21-16-1305(f), created by section 1 of this act. All Hathaway scholarship 12 recipients as of the effective date of this act shall be 13 eligible to earn an increase of the Hathaway scholarship based 14 15 on academic performance after the effective date of this act 16 in accordance with W.S. 21-16-1304(j) or 21-16-1305(f), as amended by section 1 of this act, provided that the recipients 17
