for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the department of audit; requiring a
- 2 report on evaluation requirements for small cities and
- 3 towns as specified; and providing for an effective date.

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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 Section 1.

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- 9 (a) The department of audit shall provide a report on
- 10 the audit requirements for small cities and towns and the
- 11 current application of W.S. 9-1-507(a) to those cities and
- 12 towns. The report shall include:

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1 (i) Information on how often small cities and 2 towns are evaluated under W.S. 9-1-507(a), either by the

3 department of audit or a certified public accountant,

4 including specific dates for the most recent audits of

5 cities and towns with a population of less than four

6 thousand (4,000) inhabitants;

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8 (ii) Consideration of and recommendations

9 related to requiring regular audits or other fiscal review

10 for small cities and towns and the method and frequency of

11 those audits;

13 (iii) A determination of the fiscal impacts that

14 would occur for small cities and towns and for the

15 department of audit if a regular audit or review schedule

16 was implemented;

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18 (iv) Consideration of and recommendations

19 related to reviews and procedures which enhance internal

20 control over financial operations for small cities and

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21 towns;

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1 (v) Recommendations for standardizing or 2 improving bookkeeping and financial reporting methods for 3 small cities and towns including training county 4 municipal employees in proper accounting methods under W.S. 9-1-507(a)(iv);5 6 7 (vi) Recommendations for cost effective ways to 8 independently analyze and report on financial information 9 systematic basis in conjunction with W.S. on a 10 9-1-507(a)(v). 11 12 In preparing the report required under subsection (a) of this section, the department shall consult with 13 representatives of small cities and towns that may be 14 15 impacted by the implementation of revised 16 requirements. The department shall provide an opportunity 17 for public comment on current audit requirements and on implementation of regularly scheduled audits or other 18 19 financial review for small cities and towns. 20

21 (c) The department shall provide the report required under subsection (a) of this section, including any 22 recommendations for legislation, to the joint corporations, 23

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1 elections and political subdivisions interim committee not

2 later than October 1, 2017. The joint corporations,

3 elections and political subdivisions interim committee

4 shall consider the report and develop any legislation it

5 deems appropriate for consideration by the legislature.

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7 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

8 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

9 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
