A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to a state capital construction project;
2 specifying requirements for a loan for repairs and
3 renovation to the Wyoming state veterinary biosafety
4 laboratory; modifying loan recipient to reflect government
5 reorganization; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** 2016 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 97,
10 Section 5 is amended to read:

15 **Section 5.** In addition to the authority
provided under W.S. 9-1-417, and upon approval
16 direction of the governor, the state treasurer

1 and the state auditor shall ~~direct~~ provide a no
2 interest loan from the state's risk management
3 pool to the ~~department of administration and~~
4 ~~information~~ construction management ~~program~~
5 ~~within the general services division~~ department
6 as ~~they determine~~ the governor directs and
7 determines necessary for repairs and renovation
8 to the Wyoming state veterinary biosafety level
9 III laboratory in order to achieve registration
10 by the United States Centers for Disease Control
11 and Prevention under the federal select agent
12 program for possession, use and transfer of
13 select agents and toxins. The ~~division~~
14 construction management department may expend the
15 funds as necessary to fully commission the
16 laboratory space. Proceeds collected from
17 insurers and third parties for the repairs shall
18 be used to repay the loan. The attorney general,
19 department of administration and information and
20 the University of Wyoming shall coordinate
21 efforts to recover damages to the Wyoming state
22 veterinary biosafety level III laboratory.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
4 Constitution.
