1 AN ACT relating to public assistance and social services; 2 directing participation in the federal summer electronic 3 benefit transfer program for children; specifying duties of 4 the department of family services and the department of 5 education; authorizing rulemaking; authorizing positions; 6 providing appropriations; and providing for an effective 7 date.

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## ARTICLE 6

15 SUMMER ELECTRONIC BENEFIT TRANSFER PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN 16

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1 42-2-601. Definitions. 2 3 (a) As used in this article: 4 (i) "Electronic benefit transfer" means 5 the method the state issues benefits described б in W.S. 7 42-2-102(a)(iii) for public welfare benefits; 8 9 (ii) "Summer EBT program" means the summer 10 electronic benefit transfer program for children under 42 U.S.C. § 1762. 11 12 13 42-2-602. Summer EBT program; administration and 14 management plan; rulemaking. 15 16 (a) The department shall, in accordance with 42 17 U.S.C. § 1762, administer the summer EBT benefit program to provide nutrition assistance to eligible households to 18 19 ensure continued access to food for each eligible child 20 when school is not in session for the summer. The 21 department shall issue benefits to qualifying households 22 under the summer EBT program. 23

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1 (b) The department shall develop an administration 2 and management plan for participation in the summer EBT benefit program as required in 42 U.S.C. § 1762 for each 3 4 summer of participation. The department shall submit the plans to the United States secretary of agriculture by the 5 deadlines established by the secretary. б 7 8 (c) The department of education shall provide information to the department concerning children eligible 9 10 for participation in the free and reduced price lunch program under the national school lunch program established 11 12 by 42 U.S.C. § 1751 et seq. for purposes of administering 13 the summer EBT program. 14 15 (d) The department shall adopt rules and regulations 16 as necessary to implement this section. 17 18 Section 2. W.S. 42-2-102(a)(vii) by creating a new 19 subparagraph (J) is amended to read: 20 21 42-2-102. Definitions.

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1 (a) Except as otherwise specifically provided, as 2 used in this article: 3 (vii) "Public welfare benefit" means financial 4 5 assistance provided to eligible persons in the form of a performance payment, vendor payment, supplemental nutrition 6 assistance program benefit, electronic benefit transfer or 7 8 cash. These benefits may be received from several state or 9 federal welfare programs including: 10 11 (J) Summer electronic benefit transfer 12 program for children (summer EBT program). 13 Section 3. 14 15 16 (a) The department of family services is authorized 17 up to two (2) temporary full-time positions and one (1) at-will employee contract position for the period beginning 18 19 with the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 20 2027 for purposes of this act. It is the intent of the 21 legislature that the department of family services request the positions necessary for ongoing implementation of the 22 summer EBT program for children created in section 1 of 23

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1 this act as an exception request in its supplemental budget 2 request for the second fiscal year of the immediately 3 succeeding fiscal biennium.

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(b) There is appropriated one million one hundred 5 one hundred ninety-three 6 forty thousand dollars (\$1,140,193.00) from the general fund to the department of 7 8 family services for the state's share of administrative costs related to the summer electronic benefit transfer 9 10 program created in section 1 of this act. This 11 appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2027. This 12 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 13 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds 14 15 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 16 by law on June 30, 2027. It is the intent of the 17 legislature that amounts necessary for ongoing 18 implementation of the summer EBT program for children 19 created in section 1 of this act be included as an 20 exception request in the department of family service's supplemental budget request for the second year of the 21 immediately succeeding fiscal biennium. 22

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1 (c) There is appropriated one million one hundred 2 forty thousand one hundred ninety-four dollars 3 (\$1,140,194.00) federal funds for the summer EBT program 4 created in section 1 of this act.

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6 Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon 7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 9 Constitution.
