A JOINT RESOLUTION

for

- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress to enact legislation
- 2 to remove the gray wolf and grizzly bear populations from
- 3 listing under the endangered species act and to assist in
- 4 funding programs and services for gray wolf and grizzly
- 5 bear management.

- 7 WHEREAS, gray wolf and grizzly bear predation on livestock
- 8 and big game species is resulting in economic losses in the
- 9 state of Wyoming; and

- 11 WHEREAS, the cost to manage gray wolves and grizzly bears
- 12 and to compensate individuals and entities for damage
- 13 caused by these species is significantly greater than can
- 14 be sustained through existing budgets of the responsible
- 15 state and federal agencies; and

- 2 WHEREAS, gray wolf and grizzly bear populations are
- 3 recovered and these species should therefore be removed
- 4 from the list of experimental nonessential population,
- 5 endangered species or threatened species in Wyoming in
- 6 order for the state to effectively manage these species;
- 7 and

- 9 WHEREAS, federal funding is essential now and after the
- 10 date the gray wolf and grizzly bear populations are removed
- 11 from the list of experimental nonessential population,
- 12 endangered species or threatened species in Wyoming to
- 13 assist the state in compensating individuals and entities
- 14 for losses caused by these species; and

- 16 WHEREAS, such federal support in compensating individuals
- 17 and entities for losses will increase acceptance of these
- 18 wildlife species in Wyoming and continue the healthy and
- 19 self-sustaining populations of gray wolves and grizzly
- 20 bears in the state.

- 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
- 23 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. That the Wyoming legislature calls on Congress to speedily seek removal of the gray wolf and grizzly bear populations from the list of experimental nonessential population, endangered species or threatened species in Wyoming, by all means available.

8 Section 2. That the Wyoming legislature calls on 9 Congress now and after the date the gray wolf and grizzly 10 bear populations are removed from the list of experimental nonessential population, endangered species or threatened 11 12 species in Wyoming to assist in funding necessary programs 13 and services for gray wolf and grizzly bear management, 14 particularly programs and services to compensate 15 individuals and entities for losses caused by wildlife species. 16
