7 WHEREAS, Wyoming has a strong history of self-reliance,

8 independence and providing a variety of foods to our

9 families and communities; and

11 WHEREAS, Wyoming farmers, ranchers and growers across the

12 state are establishing diversified agricultural businesses

13 which produce high quality and healthy vegetables, meats,

14 eggs, honey, milk and fruits for expanding consumer markets

15 including farmers markets, farm-to-table, restaurants,

1 community supported agriculture programs and school 2 districts; and 3 4 WHEREAS, these Wyoming producers are increasing local food 5 opportunities and increasing security, expanding job economic prosperity for Wyoming's rural 6 and 7 communities; and 8 WHEREAS, the Wyoming business council has documented that 9 local farmer's markets in Wyoming contribute over two 10 11 million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) to the local economy, local 12 agricultural markets, and create long term jobs contributing over six hundred fifty thousand dollars 13 (\$650,000.00) in labor income; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, there is great potential to expand the number and 17 diversity of local food producers in Wyoming; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming, Wyoming department of 20 agriculture, Wyoming Business Council and other agencies

- 14 grown foods to our economy, to the security of our food
- 15 supply and to the health of our citizens and recognizes
- 16 local food production as a vital component of Wyoming's
- 17 agricultural economy.

- 19 **Section 2.** That the legislature of the state of
- 20 Wyoming urges cooperative and financial support,
- 21 educational resources and technical assistance from Wyoming
- 22 executive agencies and educational institutions to promote
- 23 local food production and consumer opportunities.

2 Section 3. That the legislature of the state of 3 Wyoming supports initiatives which encourage development of 4 local and regional food systems including, but not limited to, local procurement laws, farm-to-school programs, 5 cottage foods, food hubs, independent livestock feeding 6 operations and in-state meat processing and encourages 7 8 private investment and entrepreneurship and public-private partnerships to further the establishment of a local food 9 base for Wyoming consumers. 10
