Constitutional term limits.

A JOINT RESOLUTION

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
2 Constitution by specifying term limits for specified state
3 elected offices.

4

5 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,*
6 *two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting*
7 *separately, concurring therein:*

9 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
10 Constitution, Article 6, Section 15 is proposed for
11 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
12 next general election for approval or rejection to become
13 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
14 majority of the electors at the election:

16 **Article 6, Section 15. Qualifications for office.**

2 (a) No person except a qualified elector shall be
3 elected or appointed to any civil or military office in the
4 state. "Military office" shall be limited to the offices
5 of adjutant general, assistant adjutant general for the
6 army national guard and assistant adjutant general for the
7 air national guard.

8

9 (b) In addition to any qualifications for office
10 under this constitution, no person shall be elected or
11 appointed to serve for more than two (2) consecutive terms
12 in any one (1) state office. "State office" shall include
13 state legislators, the governor, the secretary of state,
14 the state auditor, the state treasurer and the
15 superintendent of public instruction. This subsection shall
16 not apply to any term or portion of a term served in a
17 state office prior to January 1, 2016.

18

19 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
20 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

21

1 The adoption of this amendment would provide a term limit
2 of not more than two (2) consecutive terms in the same
3 office for state senators and representatives, the
4 governor, the secretary of state, the state auditor, the
5 state treasurer and the superintendent of public
6 instruction.
