2 provide by rule and regulation for the clerk to obtain and

3 use substitute ballots.

5 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section,

6 county clerks shall make official absentee ballots for

7 primary and general elections available to voters with

8 rights under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee

9 Voting Act, 42 U.S.C. 1973ff, and future acts amendatory or

10 supplemental thereto, forty-five (45) days before the

11 election.
