A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to corporations, partnerships and  
2 associations; altering licensing fees as specified; and  
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 17-14-209(a)(i), 17-16-1630(a) and (f),  
8 17-21-1101(n), 17-29-209(a) and 17-29-210(a)(i) are amended  
9 to read:

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11 **17-14-209. Fees.**

12

13 (a) The secretary of state shall charge and collect the  
14 following fees:

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1           (i) For filing a certificate of limited  
2 partnership, for an application for a certificate of  
3 continuance or for registering a foreign limited partnership,  
4 a fee of ~~one hundred dollars (\$100.00)~~one hundred twenty-five  
5 dollars (\$125.00);

6

7           **17-16-1630. Filing of reports and payment of tax**  
8 **required; amount of tax; exemptions; records.**

9

10          (a) Every corporation organized under the laws of this  
11 state and every foreign corporation which obtains the right  
12 to transact and carry on business within this state (except  
13 banks, insurance companies and savings and loan associations)  
14 shall file with the secretary of state on or before the first  
15 day of the month of registration of every year a  
16 certification, under the penalty of perjury, by its treasurer  
17 or other fiscal agent setting forth its capital, property and  
18 assets located and employed in the state of Wyoming. The  
19 statement shall give the names and addresses of its officers  
20 and directors and the address of its principal office. On or  
21 before the first day of the month of registration of every  
22 year the corporation shall pay to the secretary of state in  
23 addition to all other statutory taxes and fees a license tax

1 based upon the sum of its capital, property and assets  
2 reported, of ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ one hundred dollars  
3 (\$100.00) or two-tenths of one mill on the dollar (\$.0002),  
4 whichever is greater.

5

6 (f) In addition to other fees provided under this  
7 section, each corporation shall pay ~~one hundred dollars~~  
8 ~~(\$100.00)~~ one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) to the  
9 secretary of state for initial incorporation or qualification  
10 to do business in Wyoming.

11

12 **17-21-1101. Registered limited liability partnerships.**

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14 (n) An initial registration fee of ~~one hundred dollars~~  
15 ~~(\$100.00)~~ one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) shall be  
16 paid to the secretary of state. In addition each registered  
17 limited liability partnership and foreign limited liability  
18 partnership shall annually comply with and pay the fees  
19 provided by W.S. 17-16-1630(a) through (e) and 17-16-120(j)  
20 as if it were a corporation. Any registered foreign limited  
21 liability partnership transacting business in this state  
22 without registering or annually maintaining its registration  
23 is subject to the penalties provided by W.S. 17-16-1502(d).

2           **17-29-209. Annual report for secretary of state.**

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4           (a) Every limited liability company organized under the  
5 laws of this state and every foreign limited liability company  
6 which obtains a certificate of authority to transact and carry  
7 on business within this state shall file with the secretary  
8 of state on or before the first day of the month of  
9 organization of every year a certification, under the penalty  
10 of perjury, by its treasurer or other fiscal agent setting  
11 forth its capital, property and assets located and employed  
12 in the state of Wyoming. The statement shall give the address  
13 of its principal office. On or before the first day of the  
14 month of organization of every year the limited liability  
15 company or foreign limited liability company shall pay to the  
16 secretary of state in addition to all other statutory taxes  
17 and fees a license fee based upon the sum of its capital,  
18 property and assets reported, of ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ one  
19 hundred dollars (\$100.00) or two-tenths of one mill on the  
20 dollar (\$.0002), whichever is greater.

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22           **17-29-210. Fees; annual fee.**

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1           (a) The secretary of state shall charge and collect  
2 fees from limited liability companies and foreign limited  
3 liability companies for:

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5           (i) Filing the original articles of organization  
6 or issuing a certificate of authority for a foreign limited  
7 liability company, ~~one hundred dollars (\$100.00)~~ one hundred  
8 twenty-five dollars (\$125.00);

9

10           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2019.
