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(viii) For the purpose of exempting sales of 1 2 services and tangible personal property as an economic 3 incentive, the following are exempt: 4 5 (R) The sale of equipment used to construct coal gasification, or coal liquefaction, oxy-6 combustion or similar advanced coal facility. 7 The exemption provided by this subparagraph shall be limited to 8 9 the acquisition of equipment used in a project to make it 10 operational. The exemption shall not apply to tools and 11 other equipment used in construction of a new facility, contracted services required for construction and routine 12 13 maintenance activities nor to eguipment utilized acquired after the facility is operational. 14 15 39-16-105. the excise tax imposed by this article: 19

21 (viii) For the purpose of exempting sales of services and tangible personal property as an economic 22 incentive, the following are exempt: 23

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(G) The purchase of equipment used to 1 2 construct a new coal gasification, or coal liquefaction, 3 oxy-combustion or similar advanced coal facility. 4 exemption provided by this subparagraph shall be limited to 5 the acquisition of equipment used in a project to make it operational. The exemption shall not apply to tools and 6 other equipment used in construction of a new facility, 7 contracted services required for construction and routine 8 9 maintenance activities nor to equipment utilized or 10 acquired after the facility is operational.

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Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the 14 15 Constitution.
