9 (j) This section shall not apply to any member of the

10 legislature participating in the program solely in his

13 Section 2. This act shall not be applied to affect

the participation of any member of the legislature lawfully 14

participating as of the effective date of this act in any 15

16 of the plans subject to this act. This act shall not be

construed to prohibit participation by a state legislator 17

in any plan subject to this act if participation is based 18

19 upon employment, other qualifying status or holding of an

20 office other than as a member of the legislature.

Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
