Cease and transfer priority list.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the prioritization of municipal solid waste  
2 facilities cease and transfer projects; authorizing  
3 expenditure of previously appropriated funds; establishing a  
4 prioritized list of projects; establishing a maximum amount  
5 to be expended on projects; granting the department of  
6 environmental quality limited discretionary authority to  
7 modify the prioritized list; providing definitions; repealing  
8 a prior list of priority cease and transfer projects; and  
9 providing for an effective date.

11 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

13 **Section 1.**

14

15 (a) As used in this section:

2 (i) "Maximum amount" means the total amount to be  
3 expended on the listed project and reflects one hundred  
4 percent (100%) of the project cost, including any award by  
5 the state loan and investment board under W.S. 35-11-528;

7 (ii) "(C)" means closure project;

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9 (iii) "SWDD" means solid waste disposal district;

10

11 (iv) "(T)" means transfer projects.

13 (b) From amounts appropriated by 2013 Wyoming Session  
14 Laws, Chapter 194, Section 2(a) and (b), 2014 Wyoming Session  
15 Laws, Chapter 26, Section 333(a) and (b), 2015 Wyoming Session  
16 Laws, Chapter 142, Section 345 (priority 2), 2016 Wyoming  
17 Session Laws, Chapter 31, Section 316(a), 2018 Wyoming  
18 Session Laws, Chapter 134, Section 323(a) and other funds  
19 appropriated and authorized for program expenses, the  
20 following amounts and prioritized projects are authorized  
21 pursuant to the municipal solid waste facilities cease and  
22 transfer program created by W.S. 35-11-528:

9 (c) The department of environmental quality may modify

10 the authorized funds and the order of the projects listed in

11 the prioritized list contained in subsection (b) of this

12 section for any of the following reasons:

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14 (i) To optimize efficiency;

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16 (ii) Based on project readiness;

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18 (iii) Based on compliance with grant or loan

19 qualifications or conditions;

21 (iv) To address emergency or immediate

22 environmental concerns.

1 (d) Not later than October 15 of each year, the  
2 department of environmental quality shall report any  
3 modification of the prioritized list contained in subsection  
4 (b) of this section to the joint minerals, business and  
5 economic development interim committee and the joint  
6 appropriations committee.

8 **Section 2.** 2018 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 90 is  
9 repealed.

10

11 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon  
12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as  
13 provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
