AN ACT relating to limited liability companies; specifying standards for imposing liability on members and managers; repealing a related provision; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 17-29-304 by creating new subsections (c) and (d) is amended to read:

17-29-304. Liability of members and managers.

- (c) For purposes of imposing liability on any member or manager of a limited liability company for the debts, obligations or other liabilities of the company, a court shall consider only the following factors no one (1) of which, except fraud, is sufficient to impose liability:
 - (i) Fraud;
 - (ii) Inadequate capitalization;
- (iii) Failure to observe company formalities as required by law; and
- (iv) Intermingling of assets, business operations and finances of the company and the members to such an extent that there is no distinction between them.
- (d) In any analysis conducted under subsection (c) of this section, a court shall not consider factors intrinsic to the character and operation of a limited liability company, whether a single or multiple member limited liability company. Factors intrinsic to the character and

operation of a limited liability company include but are
not limited to:

- (i) The ability to elect treatment as a disregarded or pass-through entity for tax purposes;
- including the failure to observe any particular formality relating to the exercise of the company's powers or management of its activities;
- (iii) The exercise of ownership, influence and
 governance by a member or manager;
- personal assets from the obligations and acts of the limited liability company.

Section 2. W.S. 17-29-304(b) is repealed.
