State parks-acquisition of LX Bar ranch.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state parks and cultural resources;
2 authorizing the acceptance of lands as specified; providing
3 an appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.**

8

9 (a) The legislature authorizes the acceptance of the
10 following donated lands located in Campbell County,
11 Wyoming, commonly known as the LX Bar Ranch, to be managed
12 by the department of state parks and cultural resources
13 upon final negotiation with the appropriate parties:

14

15 (i) Track 82 and the portion of Track 53A north
16 of the Powder River, all within Township 57 North, Range 76

1 West, Sections 10, 11, 14, 15, containing twenty-five (25)
2 acres more or less.

3

4 **Section 2.** There is appropriated two hundred eighty
5 thousand dollars (\$280,000.00) from the general fund to the
6 department of state parks and cultural resources for the
7 period beginning with the effective date of this act and
8 ending June 30, 2014 for purposes of funding the
9 stabilization and preservation of the LX Bar Ranch
10 described in section 1(a) of this act. Notwithstanding any
11 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be
12 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any
13 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this
14 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,
15 2014.

17 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
18 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
19 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
20 Constitution.
