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12 **19-7-101.** Definitions.

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14 (a) As used in this act:

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1 (iv) "Military department" means the adjutant general, the and those divisions of the army national 2 3 guard, the air national guard and state military affairs 4 that may be authorized by federal authority; 5 19-7-102. Creation and 6 composition of military 7 department. 8 9 The military department of the state of Wyoming 10 shall consist of the adjutant general and the following three (3) those divisions: that may be authorized by 11 12 federal authority. 13 14 19-7-103. No officer possesses a property interest in any duty 12 position. The adjutant general is the discharge authority 13 14

Any officer may be discharged from the Wyoming national guard according to procedures established by orders and regulations prescribed or promulgated by the adjutant general or according to federal law and regulation. An officer discharged from the United States air force or army reserves or who has his federal recognition withdrawn shall also be discharged from the Wyoming national guard effective as of the date of

1 discharge from the reserves or withdrawal of federal 2 recognition. 3 **Section 2.** W.S. 19-7-102(a)(i) through (iii) and 4 5 19-7-105(a)(i) through (iii) are repealed. 6 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 9
