A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to water development projects; providing  
 2 for construction of dams and reservoirs; authorizing  
 3 construction of designated water projects; describing  
 4 projects; specifying terms and conditions of funding for  
 5 projects; providing appropriations; modifying project  
 6 descriptions and terms of appropriations for various  
 7 specified prior projects; and providing for an effective  
 8 date.

10 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

12 **Section 1.** W.S. 99-3-1701 through 99-3-1704 are  
13 created to read:

18 **99-3-1701. Definitions.**

19  
20 The definitions in W.S. 99-3-101 apply to this article.

21  
22 **99-3-1702. General authorization.**

23  
24 The provisions of W.S. 99-3-102 apply to this article.

25  
26 **99-3-1703. Level III construction projects - new**  
27 **development.**

28  
29 (a) Authorization is granted for the Level III new  
30 development construction projects identified in this  
31 section subject to the general conditions specified in W.S.  
32 99-3-103.

1           (b) Project - Big Horn Regional Well Connection:

3           (i) Project sponsor: Big Horn Regional Joint  
4 Powers Board;

5  
6           (ii) Project purpose: Municipal, rural domestic  
7 water supply;

8  
9           (iii) Project description: Design and  
10 construction of a well connection, pipeline, and  
11 appurtenances necessary to make the project function in the  
12 manner intended;

13  
14           (iv) Total project budget: Seven million sixty  
15 thousand dollars (\$7,060,000.00);

16  
17           (v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall  
18 grant to the sponsor from water development account I  
19 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,  
20 project land procurement, construction engineering and  
21 construction of the project an amount not to exceed four  
22 million seven hundred thirty thousand two hundred dollars  
23 (\$4,730,200.00) or sixty-seven percent (67%) of the actual  
24 development costs, whichever is less;

26           (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from  
27 water development account I to the commission four million

13 (30) years from the date the commission determines project  
14 benefits accrue to the sponsor, at an annual rate of four  
15 percent (4%);

17 (vii) Appropriation: There is appropriated from  
18 water development account II to the commission ~~two hundred~~  
19 ~~ten thousand dollars (\$210,000.00)~~ one million six hundred  
20 twenty thousand dollars (\$1,620,000.00) or as much thereof  
21 as is necessary to carry out the purpose of this  
22 subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this  
23 subsection shall revert to water development account II on  
24 July 1, ~~2016~~ 2017.

29 **Section 4.** This act is effective immediately upon
