1 AN ACT relating to school districts; authorizing surplus food
2 programs in schools; authorizing donation of surplus school
3 food to a nonprofit entity; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-3-111(a)(xi) is amended to read:

9

10 **21-3-111. Powers of boards of trustees.**

11

12 (a) The board of trustees in each school district
13 within the state may:

14

15 (xi) Provide for the operation of :

16

1 (A) School lunch programs in schools under
2 its jurisdiction;

3
4 (B) Programs that provide surplus food at no
5 cost to students for a snack or breakfast, lunch or dinner
6 meal for students who are unable to purchase a snack or
7 breakfast, lunch or dinner meal. Surplus food provided under
8 a school program may include unserved food, whether packaged
9 or unpackaged, whole produce, wrapped raw produce or unpeeled
10 fruit. A school district may accept and use food donated by
11 a nonprofit entity for its surplus food program;

12
13 (C) Programs to donate surplus school food to
14 a nonprofit entity for a charitable purpose.

15
16 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2020.
