A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to gaming; repealing the sunset date  
2 applicable to skill based amusement games; requiring  
3 applicable fees to be paid on an annual basis; and  
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** 2020 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 114,  
9 Section 1(a), (c), (e), (h) and (k) is amended to read:

13 (a) Notwithstanding W.S. 6-7-102, skill  
14 based amusement games operating in the state  
15 prior to ~~the effective date of this section~~ March

1       17, 2020 shall be allowed to continue operation  
2       ~~until June 30, 2021~~ in accordance with the  
3       requirements of this section.

5           (c) ~~Within sixty (60) days of the effective~~  
6       ~~date of this section~~ A skill based amusement game  
7       that meets the requirements of this section shall  
8       be approved by the commission to continue  
9       operating in the state or it shall be removed  
10       from the state by the operator.

11  
12           (e) Skill based amusement games that meet  
13       the requirements of this section shall bear a  
14       commission issued decal that identifies the  
15       operator of the game. Each decal shall be valid  
16       for one (1) year. No skill based amusement game  
17       shall be operational unless it bears a current  
18       commission issued decal. The commission shall  
19       charge a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a  
20       decal. Each decal shall include the bucking horse  
21       and rider emblem. The annual fee required under  
22       this section shall be paid on or before July 1 of  
23       each year. Fees collected shall be deposited to

1 the commission gaming account, which is hereby  
2 created. ~~For the period from the effective date~~  
3 ~~of this section through June 30, 2021,~~ Funds  
4 within the account are continuously appropriated  
5 to the commission to pay for reasonable expenses  
6 incurred to administer this section.

7  
8 (h) No establishment shall have more than  
9 four (4) skill based amusement games at any one  
10 (1) time. Only an establishment that had a skill  
11 based amusement game operating within the  
12 establishment as of ~~the effective date of this~~  
13 ~~section~~ March 17, 2020 may continue to have a  
14 skill based amusement game operating pursuant to  
15 this section.

17 (k) An establishment shall pay the  
18 commission ~~a~~ an annual fee of two hundred fifty  
19 dollars (\$250.00) to continue to have skill based  
20 amusement games in the establishment. ~~until June~~  
21 ~~30, 2021.~~ Operators of skill based amusement  
22 games shall pay the commission ~~a~~ an annual fee of  
23 two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) to
