12 (a) As used in this article:

- 14 (xli) "Food for domestic home consumption" means
- 15 food for domestic home consumption as defined by department
- 16 rule and regulation substances whether in liquid,

2	are sold for ingestion or chewing by humans and are
3	consumed for their taste or nutritional value. "Food for
4	domestic home consumption" does not include alcoholic
5	beverages, tobacco or prepared foods;

11	(I) Food sold in a heated state or
12	heated by the seller;
