- 7 **Section 1**. W.S. 11-28-106 by creating a new
- 8 subsection (c) is amended to read:

- 10 11-28-106. Construction and maintenance of partition
- 11 fences; fencing of state lands.

- 13 (c) Landowners whose property adjoins state lands on
- 14 which the landowner does not hold a lease may construct a
- 15 lawful partition fence along state lands and the office of

1	state lands and investments shall pay for one-half (1/2) of
2	the actual cost of the construction of the lawful partition
3	fence. Landowners and the office of state lands and
4	investments shall contribute to the cost of maintenance of
5	the lawful partition fence in proportion to their
6	respective interests in the fence.

8	Section 2. The office of state lands and investments
9	shall promulgate all rules necessary to implement this act.
10	
11	Section 3.

13	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
14	section, this act is effective July 1, 2025.
15	
16	(b) Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective
17	immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a
18	bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of
19	the Wyoming Constitution.
