- 8 creating a new subparagraph (Q) and 7-2-101(a)(iv)(M), (N)
- 9 and by creating a new subparagraph (0) are amended to read:

11 **6-1-104.** Definitions.

- 13 (a) As used in W.S. 6-1-101 through 6-10-203 unless
- 14 otherwise defined:

1	(vi) "Peace officer" includes the following
2	officers assigned to duty in the state of Wyoming:

4	(O) The director and full-time staff
5	instructors of the Wyoming law enforcement academy when
6	duly appointed and acting pursuant to W.S. 9-1-633(b); and
7	
8	(P) Any superintendent, assistant
9	superintendent or full-time park ranger of any state park,
10	state recreation area, state archeological site or state
11	historic site who has qualified pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701
12	through 9-1-707, when acting within the boundaries of the
13	state park, state recreation area, state archeological site
14	or state historic site or when responding to a request to
15	assist other peace officers acting within the scope of
16	their official duties in their own jurisdiction; and

18	(Q) Any duly authorized court security
19	officer employed by the Wyoming supreme court who is
20	qualified pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701 through 9-1-707 when:

22	(I) Enforcing Wyoming statutes or
